

## CLE Financial Hardship Policy

Illinois attorneys who are unable to afford continuing legal education program registration fees due to financial hardship may petition for registration fee waivers or discounted program fees. To apply, the applicant must

- (1) submit the request on letterhead;
- (2) sign the request; and
- (3) submit proof of income or an explanation stating why the normal fee associated with the program causes the lawyer financial hardship.

Fee waivers will not include reduction in meals, lodging, or travel costs associated with the course. Scholarships will be awarded on a space-available basis, with preference given to applicants in order of date submitted. CIMMcon will waive or reduce meeting registration fees at their discretion.
